## MAIDEN CONVOCATION CEREMONY

### PROGRAMME OF ACTIVITIES AND INFORMATION FOR GRADUANDS

This is to inform the general public and the 2010/2011 graduands of the University, in particular, that the First Convocation Ceremony of the University holds on Saturday, January 28, 2012 to admit graduating students to first degrees and present prizes to deserving students.

As part of the ceremony, the University will install Senator Bode Olajumoke as its first Chancellor, who will also be conferred with an Honorary Doctorate Degree. The following eminent personalities will also receive Honorary Doctorate Degrees of the University:

- i. Dr. Olusegun Abayomi Mimiko, Governor of Ondo State
- ii. Ogbeni Rauf Adesoji Aregbesola, Governor of Osun State
- iii. Elder Simeon Morounfolu Olusola Olakunri, *SAN, FCI Arb.*

The ceremony will kick off with a Press Briefing on Friday, January 20, 2012 at the Senate Chamber of the University. The general programme is as indicated below:

## INFORMATION FOR GRADUANDS

1. All the 2010/2011 final year students are advised to check their names on the list of graduands displayed on the University website: [www.achievers.edu.ng](http://www.achievers.edu.ng)

2. Graduands are expected at the Interdenominational Service holding on Sunday, January 22, 2012 at St. Andrews Cathedral, Owo by 1 pm.

3. Each graduand is entitled to two invitation cards for his/her guests who are allowed to the Convocation Arena shall be allowed to invite a maximum of four guests in the Convocation Arena. The invitation cards can be collected at the Registry.

4. Babies and children below the age of 10 are not allowed into the Convocation Arena.

5. It is compulsory for all graduands to attend the Convocation Ceremony. However, those who may not be able to attend for any reason are expected to give the Registrar prior notice.

Please note that graduands will collect their certificates during the ceremony. Those who fail to do so at the arena will pay a penalty of N10,000.

6. It is mandatory for all graduands to pay for the following items, irrespective of whether or not they are attending the Convocation:

a. Hiring of academic outfit	= N5,000
b. Order of Proceedings	= N1,000
c. Certificate and scroll	= N10,000
	<u>N16,000</u>

**All the graduating students who have not paid their alumni project fee of N20,000 should do so before Convocation Day.**

Payment can be made in cash to the Bursary **or** the following bank accounts: WEMA Bank Plc. Account No 0122042399 and Oceanic Bank Plc Account No 0050514703

7. Collection of academic outfits and Order of Proceedings will commence as from Thursday, January 26, 2012 at the Registry on presentation of receipt for fees indicated in Paragraph 6 above.

8. All graduands are expected to attend a rehearsal of the Academic Procession on Friday, January 26, 2012 at the Permanent Site by 3 pm. Graduands who fail to attend the rehearsal may not be allowed to participate in the graduands' procession.

9. All graduands are expected to dress formally, decently and corporately (i.e. suit for men, skirt suit or gown for women).

10. Every graduating student is expected to provide a staff guarantor for the return of the academic gown in proper condition. The guarantor will be expected to pay replacement cost to the University if the graduand fails to return the gown by **Monday, January 30, 2012**. Completed guarantor form must be submitted at the time of collection of academic gown.
